Big Idea: When His name matters greatly to us, our name will matter greatly to Him.

In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him **Jesus**." (Luke 1:26-32)

She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name **Jesus**, because he will save his people from their sins." (Matthew 1:21)

On the eighth day, when it was time to circumcise the child, he was named **Jesus**, the name the angel had given him before he was conceived. (Luke 2:21)

- **In His name: guaranteed salvation.**

- **In His name: irrevocable adoption.**

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. (John 15:16)

- **In His name: unbelievable production.**

Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name, the name you gave me, so that they may be one as we are one. (John 17:11)

- **In His name: impenetrable protection.**

Then Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk." (Acts 3:6)
